Urbanisation: Changes of the built environment

Concept:

This workshop focuses on the visible changes of land-use, construction and architecture in urbanising landscapes. In three inputs should be highlighted the underlying driving forces of these changes: the economic interests of investors and external and local stakeholders; the socio-cultural development with new demands in residences, leisure possibilities and amenities; the search for answers by architects while working for traditional and new stakeholders. Foreseen are:

- **Valentin Bearth** (CH-Chur, asked): New concepts for the built environment

The synthesis should answer questions to the structure of the future stakeholders in the mountains with their needs and interests in the constructed environment and possible strategies to steer this transformation process.
