Poster Award for Alpine Research Poster session on October 6, 2010, 19.30, in Munich

ForumAlpinum 2010 will include a **Poster Session related to the theme of « mountain research » on October 6, 19.30** followed by a poster exhibition during the whole conference. The poster session aims to give young researchers (students or post-docs) in both natural and social sciences fields, an opportunity to gain experience presenting material to the research community and value their results.

The poster session will take place in a dedicated place with easy access for all participants. The best two posters (one in social sciences, the other in natural sciences) will be selected by a jury of ISCAR members and guests. The authors of these posters will receive an award of € 500 each sponsored by the Information and Observation System of the Alpine Convention.

Poster Size: A 0 (841mm × 1189mm), only vertical.

Language: English (or an alpine language)

Participant obligations:

- * Submit a pdf-file of the poster topic by September 30 2010 (will be published online after the ForumAlpinum)
- * Register for ForumAlpinum 2010 (at least one of the authors)
- * Prepare a poster and install it on October 6, 2010, until 18.00

Criteria used by the jury in the evaluation of the Posters:

- Novelty and innovation in research: max. 20 points
- Relevance: scientific relevance and/or relevance to current policy issues in relation to sustainable development in the Alps: max. 20 points?
- Clarity of style and presentation: max. 20 points
